

## **PENN TOWNSHIP SEWAGE AUTHORITY**

### **SEWER MAINTENANCE WORKER**

#### **One (1) POSITION AVAILABLE**

**JOB DESCRIPTION:** Functions under and reports to the field supervisor. In addition to the list of responsibilities provided below, each sewer maintenance worker must be available for after-hours and weekend emergencies situations. A sewer maintenance worker is an hourly employee and eligible to receive overtime compensation.

- Functions under and reports directly to the Field Supervisor/ Crew Leader
- Operates and maintains trucks, backhoes, pumps, compressors, jack hammers and other tools used to replace and repair sanitary sewer collection system.
- Performs routine maintenance and repair of all pump station equipment and components as well as general labor including lawn care.
- Performs labor involved in the installation, repair and replacement of lateral and main lines, including the excavation and backfilling of trenches.
- Performs smoke and dye tests, operates and maintains CCTV equipment to determine condition of sewers.
- Will be required to obtain a NASSCO CCTV operators' license.
- Must be available for afterhours, weekend and Holiday emergency situations.
- Holds and maintains a valid CDL Class A with a tanker endorsement.
- Obtain and maintain an E-4 wastewater license.

Applicant must meet the following requirements:

- High School Graduate or GED.
- Valid PA Driver's License.
- Pass pre-employment drug/alcohol test.
- Pass criminal background check.
- Experience with all aspects of sanitary sewer work.
- Mechanical and electrical skills.
- Basic computer skills.
- Be able to work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Ability to perform physical labor.
- Must be available for call outs, Evenings and Weekends.
- CDL Class A- we will entertain training to obtain Class A CDL after 180 day probation period.
- Must provide 3 character references.
